

What does Covid 19 mean for your Whanganui River canoe journey?

1. Rest assured that if your trip is cancelled due to Covid Level Restrictions you will receive a full refund of all monies paid to Blazing Adventures.
2. Don't forget to bring your face mask, hand sanitiser and mobile phone for scanning QR codes at campsites.
3. All participants will be asked if they have cold or flu symptoms and we highly recommend that anyone with these symptoms stays home (your payment will be fully refunded).
4. DOC huts and campsites are open at Level 2. Visitors must follow these guidelines:
 - Try to keep 2m of separation
 - Face coverings are strongly encouraged to be worn inside huts if 2m spacing is not possible and it's practical to do so.
 - Bring a tent, or consider cancelling your trip, if you are concerned about sharing hut facilities.
 - Take your own cleaning and hygiene products.
 - Use QR codes where available to scan in or use intentions books at huts to enable contact tracing.
5. Bookings for DOC huts and campsites at Level 2 or above may be cancelled for a full refund.
6. In the event of a potential positive Covid 19 case on the Whanganui River, DOC may decide to close the Whanganui Journey. In this case any upcoming canoe trips will be cancelled and fully refunded.
